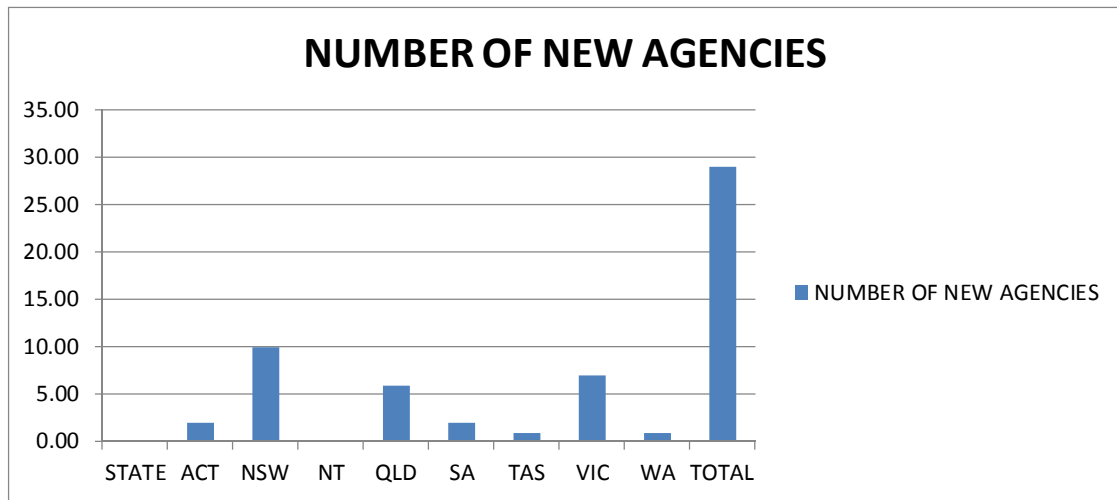


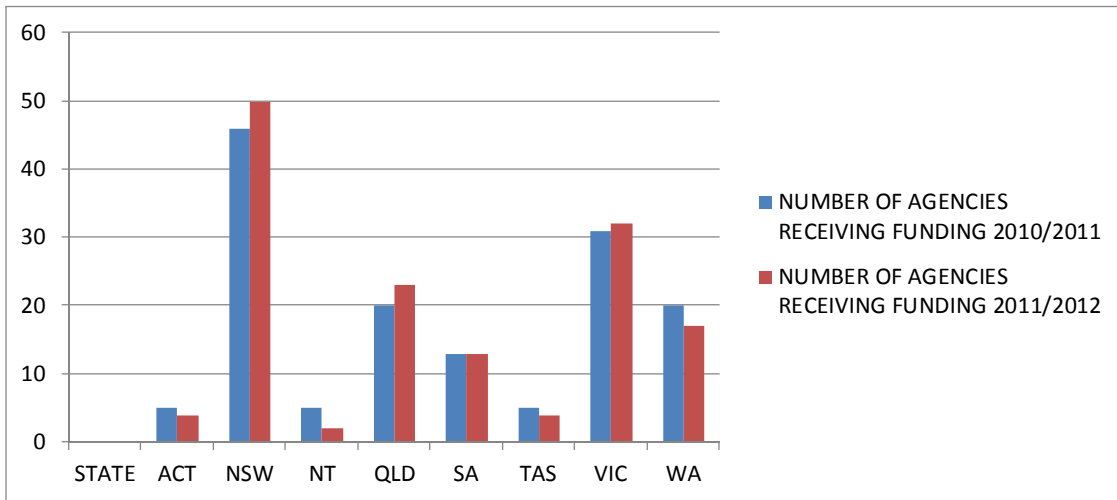
## Settlement Grants Program 2011/2012

The Settlement Grants Program (SGP) is a Federal Government grant program which provides funding to organisations to help new arrivals settle in Australia.\* Below is a basic analysis comparing funding received by organisations conducting programs targeted at assisting recently arrived migrants in Australia. The data contained in this report has been collated from the Department of Immigration and Citizenship website [www.immi.gov.au](http://www.immi.gov.au)

Firstly is an overview of the number of agencies who did not receive SGP funding in the 2010/2011 round, but have received some in the 2011/2012 round.



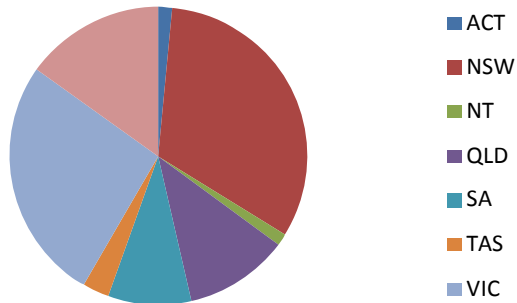
Below is a break down of the total number of agencies who have received funding in 2010/2011 vs 2011/2012 by state. In total there were 143 in 2010/2011 and 146 in 2011/2012.

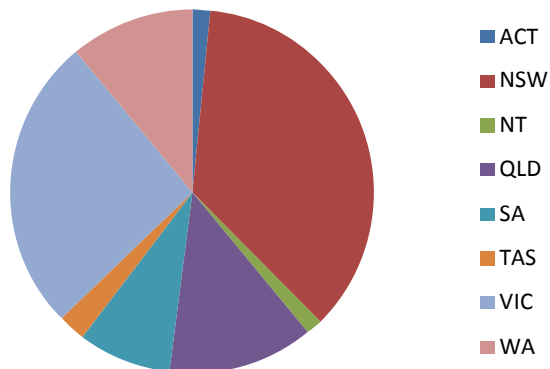
